She worked and managed the kitchen at the Senior Friendship Center. She was a volunteer Grandma at the local grade school until she was injured in 2004 and had to retire. Most of her adult life she was also a care giver for the sick and elderly. June enjoyed embroidery, making photo collages, gardening, feeding the squirrels and birds, and collecting shoes. She was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints where she sang in the choir and she also was a member of the Presbyterian Church Choir. June is survived by three
