She enjoyed baking, crocheting, working in her flower beds, and most recently Farmville on Facebook. She was a member of Our Savior Lutheran Church in Torrington and her faith in God is what was most important to her and got her through all her trials throughout her life and especially during her illness. Her greatest love of all was the love for her family. She always made sure that each one of them felt special and loved. She got the biggest joy when she spoiled her grandchildren. She will always and forever be in our hearts and greatly missed by all who knew her.
