Kathy and daughter, Karlyn, then ran the Bigfoot Trucking Company until 1997 when they sold it and moved to Sedona, Arizona. They moved back to Cheyenne, Wyoming in 1999 and then moved to Torrington, Wyoming briefly, before settling in Yoder, Wyoming in 2005. Kathy enjoyed gardening and loved being around animals of all kinds. She is

survived by her two daughters, Jalen (Kevin) Fair of Salmon, Idaho; and Karlyn (Lee Roy) Najera of Yoder, Wyoming; a sister Tamara (Ole) Bjorkedal and a brother, Michael (Lois) Niemeyer all of Minneapolis, Minnesota. She was preceded in death by her parents.
