She grew up and attended grade school at Trunk Butte School near Chadron and graduated Chadron High School in 1975. She attended one year at Grace College of the Bible in Omaha, Nebraska and then attended nursing school in Scottsbluff, Nebraska where she received a Degree in Nursing. She went back to attend Grace College for three more years and during that time did private duty nursing in family homes. In 1983 she came back to Whitney, Nebraska to help run the family farm. It was there she met and later married Jerry Scott on September 14, 1984 in Chadron. They worked and lived on his family's ranch until June 2007 when they moved to the Goshen Hole area southwest of Lingle, Wyoming. Kathy loved gardening, photography, and especially home-schooling her daughters. She worked in many church organizations and was a Sunday School teacher. Kathy is survived by her husband Jerry and her two daughters

Melody Scott and Tamara Scott and her fiancé Jesse Morehead all of Lingle, Wyoming; her mother Fern Eleson of Whitney, Nebraska; three brothers, Duane Eleson of Whitney, Kenneth Eleson of Brighton, Colorado, and Kevin Eleson of Spring Creek, Nevada; and two sisters, twin, Kay Curtis of Guthrie, Oklahoma, and Bonnie Eleson of Chadron, Nebraska.
