



Keith Owen Perry

Memorial Services for KEITH OWEN PERRY, 94, will be held December 5th, 2022, 1:30pm at North Hills Baptist Church, Lingle, WY with Pastor David Anderson officiating. Burial with military honors will follow in the Hillcrest Cemetery in Lingle, and cremation has taken place. Colyer Funeral Home in Torrington, WY is in charge of arrangements. Keith was born in Rockport, MO to John Lafayette "Lafe" Perry and Eva A. Evans. Keith spent his early years in SW Iowa. He moved to Kansas City, KS with his mom and stepdad. He left KC at the age of 1-5, going to Colorado and worked on ranches in Colorado, New Mexico and Arizona. Keith then found Estes Park and the Longs Peak Inn which became home.

He joined the Coast Guard - Navy, spending 42 mos. overseas or on ships. Upon his discharge, he returned to Colorado. In 1954 he married Ann Cooper and from this union he had 4 children. Keith worked as a horseshoer and was a Brand Inspector for the State of Colorado. He transferred to the CO Dept. of Ag., Livestock Disease Control. Later he owned 2 Western Stores, the Cowpoke Shop (Loveland, CO) and Perry's Cowboy Store (Laramie, WY). He had the Laramie Store from 1954 to 1973.

He married Kathie in 1979 and was joined by 4 more children, whom he loved like his own. During this time, he was employed by the WY Livestock Board, becoming a Livestock Enforcement Officer, retiring in 1991. We bought and built a ranch north of Fort Laramie, WY., then moved to Lingle, WY. Keith is

survived by his wife of 43 years, Kathie, Lingle, WY; children John Perry (Partner, Sheri), Laramie, WY; Joe Perry, Fort Laramie, WY; Janice Perry, Santa Cruz, CA; Jill, Perry, Loveland, CO; Chad (Renee')Nelson, Page, A7; Dave (Misty) Nelson, Redding, CA; Stacy Engelbrecht, Lingle, WY and Sherry (George) Kirkikis, Lingle, WY. He has 15 Grandchildren and 9 Great-Grandchildren. Keith was preceded in death by his parents and his sister, Joy.
