He moved to Guernsey, Wyoming in 1953 and started working for CF&I at the Sunrise Mine as a chemist. He married Myra Lou Froehlich on July 9, 1955 in Torrington. They lived in Guernsey for two years and he joined the U.S. Army in 1957 and served in France as a communications specialist. After his discharge he returned to Guernsey and the Sunrise Mine. They moved to Veteran in 1962. He retired from the mine in 1982 after it shut down. From 1982 until 2002 he was a Goshen County bus driver. Kenneth loved hunting and fishing and especially spending time with his grandchildren. Kenneth is survived by his wife Myra Lou of Veteran, Wyoming; two daughters, Andrea Eisenbarth and her husband Tim, and Charlotte Steben and her husband Mike all of

Torrington, Wyoming; a son Darren Youngs of Veteran; a sister Bernita Youngs of Denver, Colorado; a brother Lowell Youngs of Whitewater, Wisconsin; and four grandchildren, Isaac Eisenbarth, Jacob Steben, Chelsea Eisenbarth, and Blake Steben. He was preceded in death by his parents; and one sister.
