He attended two years at Eastern Wyoming College and then went on to finish his education at Fort Hays State University in Kansas.

Kevin enjoyed all sports but his heart belonged to baseball. He played from T-Ball through college at Fort Hays State University. He also enjoyed coaching and umpiring.

Kevin is survived by his parents Ronald and Loretta Nab, two sisters Wendy

(Greg) Posten and Denise (Randy) Hill all of Torrington, Wyoming; nephews Brett Posten, Chris and Heath Hill, Anthony and Nathaniel Dominguez; niece Shali (Jordon) Courtney; three great nephews; and many aunts, uncles, cousins and friends. He was preceded in death by both grandparents Harold and Helen Nab and Herman and Rachel Hartung.
