Kirby farmed and ranched all his life in LaGrange except for a two year stint, 1940 to 1942, which he spent in Los Angeles, California where he worked for Lockheed Corporation helping to build P-38 aircraft. Kirby was a member of the LaGrange Bible Church and served as a board member and treasurer for many years. He also served as a board member of the Frontier School of the Bible from its origin for 24 years. He is survived by his wife Lottie of LaGrange; his five children; Kay (Lyle) Ball of LaGrange, Wyoming; Myron (Sally) Tremain of Lincoln, Nebraska; twins,

Kenneth (Sharon) Tremain of LaGrange and Kathy (Mahlon) Anderson of Worland, Wyoming; and Richard (Peggy) Tremain of Laramie, Wyoming; 15 grandchildren, 23 great grandchildren, and four great-great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, and one sister Gene Vetter.
