He enjoyed his days golfing in Morrill with his good friend George; they could also be found harassing the refs on the sidelines of games. In addition, he liked to go to the feedlot office to watch video cattle sales with Bill and Linda.

Larry will always be remembered for his infectious smile, his ornery attitude, and his love for the people that were in his life.

We couldn't have asked for a better brother, father, and grandpa, and we will miss Larry every day. His memory will live on in the hearts of all those who loved him.
