He rented a farm near Yoder until 1965 when he purchased a farm south of Lingle. He remained living on that farm until March of 2008 when he moved to the Goshen Care Center. Leon loved to farm and was in the top 10 sugar beet producers for Holly Sugar twice. He also enjoyed feeding cattle. Bingo was his favorite pastime and he made many lasting friendships through the years. He was a member of the First Congregational Church in Torrington, where he served as trustee, deacon, and in Men's League. He also enjoyed attending the Torrington Baptist Tabernacle Church with friends while living at the Care Center. He was instrumental in forming the Angell Draw Drainage District and was a board member for 30 years. Leon is survived by his son Dennis and
