LeRoy was born on August 3, 1929 in Scottsbluff, Nebraska the son of Henry, Sr and Molly (Temple) Feagler. He attended school at Scottsbluff and in 1944 moved with his family to Torrington, Wyoming where he continued his education. He married Arlene Weickum at Torrington on February 5, 1950 and the couple farmed south of Torrington and later in the Sheep Creek and Huntley areas. LeRoy and Arlene then bought a farm south of Torrington and one north of Torrington. The couple also owned and operated the Torrington Sod Farm. LeRoy served on the Goshen Irrigation District Board of Directors for 22 years. He received the outstanding young farmer award and he received the Headgate award from Four States Irrigation Council. LeRoy was also an FFA Honorary Chapter Farmer. He enjoyed antique tractors and tractor pulls, and he liked to watch baseball.
