She was the first daughter and fourth of six children born to Harold Henry and Vivian Lois (Haas) Hill. She attended Lingle public schools; graduating in 1968. She went on to attend and graduate from Eastern Wyoming College in 1970 and then enrolled at the University of Wyoming where she graduated in 1972. In 1971, she began training at a school of medical technology in Chicago, Illinois and while residing in Chicago, Lois met her future husband, John Arville, who was studying and practicing radiology. On August 18, 1974 Lois and John were united in marriage at the Community Presbyterian Church in Lingle. Their son Alan was born on March 11, 1978 and another son Brent, January 14, 1980. During her married life, Lois resided in Chicago, Wauseon, Ohio, and Las Vegas, Nevada with a secondary home in the Philippines. She is remembered professionally as a medical technologist and personally as a devoted wife and mother. But having inherited, through her father's family, an abnormal gene which precipitates Early Onset Alzheimer's Disease, and having manifested

those symptoms progressively since 2002, Lois died at her home in the Philippines on October 11, 2010. She is survived by her husband, John; sons, Alan and Brent, daughter-in-law Jeanette, grandsons Braden (age 4) and Samuel (age 2); her mother, Vivian; three brothers Roger, Curtis, and Steve, and a sister Jeannette. She was preceded in death by her father in 1986, a brother Royce in 2003, and a sister-in-law Barbara Hill in 2004.
