He enjoyed traveling and playing bridge and checkers. He loved following his kids and grandkids sporting activities. He is survived by his wife, Opal of LaGrange, Wyoming; daughter Myrna Smith Carroll of Lingle, Wyoming; two sons, Vern Scheer and his wife Jolene of Kinnear, Wyoming; and Doug Scheer and his wife Peggy of LaGrange, Wyoming; eight grandchildren, 11 great
