January 14, 1918 - March 29, 2013

A Funeral Mass of Christian burial will be celebrated for LUGARDITA ESQUIBEL, 95, at 10am Wednesday, April 3, 2013 at St. Rose Catholic Church with Father Ray Moss officiating.
