The couple then moved to Ft. Laramie, Wyoming where they purchased the Ft. Laramie Bar. They operated the bar for 20 plus years before moving back to Torrington in 1974 and Marge worked at Downing & Reed until her retirement in 1985. Marge was a member of the All Saints Episcopal Church in Torrington. She was a member of the Ft. Laramie Community Club,

the South East Wyoming Art Association, and a member of the Business and Professional Women in Worland, Wyoming for two years. Marge was also a member of the Garden Club and the Yank Service Organization. She enjoyed yard and garage sales and gardening. Marge was involved in the Foster Grandparent Program at the Torrington Learning Center which she enjoyed immensely. She is survived by her two daughters, Elaine Susan Gering of Alexandria, Virginia, and Aimee L. Unverzagt and her husband David of Lingle, Wyoming; two grandsons, William D.
