They lived on a farm and helped his father farm. They moved to Bradshaw, Nebraska and rented a farm and in 1972 they bought into a farming operation in O'Neill, Nebraska. He retired in 2008 and they moved to Torrington, Wyoming.

Marie enjoyed gardening, crocheting, sewing, cooking and baking.
