Mark Bullington, a beloved husband, father, papa, teacher, and coach, passed away peacefully at his home on December 18th, 2024 surrounded by his cherished family and loving dogs. Born in North Platte, Nebraska, in 1957, Mark grew up amidst the beauty of the Sandhills, fostering a deep connection to his community and a lifelong passion for the outdoors. He graduated from Hyannis High School in 1975, excelling academically and leaving an enduring mark on his classmates and teachers. His love for sports led him to Chadron State College, where he played football and wrestled, embodying the discipline and camaraderie that would characterize his life. He graduated from Chadron State College in 1979. After graduating in 1979, Mark married the love of his life Kerry (Pomeroy). They later welcomed three children; Jamie Kistler, Matt Bullington and Steven

Bullington. In August of 1979, Mark embarked on a fulfilling career in industrial arts education. From 1979-1982, he taught industrial arts and coached football, basketball, and track in Lyman, Nebraska. He then dedicated himself to Southeast High School from 1982-2024, where he continued his teaching career and made an indelible impact as a football, wrestling, and track coach. During his tenure at Southeast, he led nine state championship football teams, appearing in eleven championship games, touching the lives of countless athletes and students from Southeast and beyond his own school. Beyond his impressive coaching achievements, Mark was an inspiring educator who nurtured not just athletes but young minds, encouraging creativity and innovation. His influence extended far beyond the classroom and playing field, shaping the lives of countless students who remember him with deep respect and gratitude. More than an educator, Mark was a devoted family man. He loved deeply, sharing his warmth, laughter, and life lessons emphasizing kindness and resilience with his wife, children, and grandchildren. He celebrated every moment, big or small, with those he loved. Mark's legacy is one of unwavering dedication to his family, students, and community. He selflessly volunteered his time, coordinating numerous school and community events, and tirelessly working to ensure that young people realized their full potential. His kindness and encouraging words will forever echo in the hearts of those he touched.
