Marlene was born February 6, 1934, at the family home near Lyman on the Nebraska/Wyoming border, the daughter of William and Bertha (Ehrlich) Keller. As a child she worked on the family farm and helped to raise her six younger brothers and sisters. She remained very close to her siblings throughout her life. She graduated from Lingle High School in 1952 and married Sam Wagner on June 8, 1952. The couple was married 67 years until Sam's death in February of 2020.

Marlene's hobbies included painting, bridge, gardening and knitting. She also belonged to the Red Hat Ladies Club and was an Elder at the Lingle Presbyterian Church.
