May 25, 1929 - March 9, 2021

On March 9, 2021 Max Robinett joined his loving wife of 68 years, Iona, in Heaven. Max was born May 25, 1929. In his words, “if they ask, tell them that I was born in an old rock house 6-8 miles south of Bloomington, NE during the Dust Bowl”. When he was 3 years old, he and his family moved to Wyoming in a ‘30’s model Chevrolet with wooden spoke wheels. His dad purchased a farm 11 miles west of Jay Em, WY. Max grew up there and farmed and ranched with his dad raising dryland crops and registered Angus cattle. Max and Iona eventually purchased the farm and remained there until 2005 when they moved to Torrington. Max enjoyed sharing memories with his family even during his last days on Earth. His Granddaughter wrote that he had an unmatched sense of humor and was the hardest working man she had ever met. He worked day and night to provide a beautiful life for his family for a generation. Max wondered what would be said about a man who lived a clean life. Along with his farm and ranch operation he enjoyed hunting, playing pinochle, and spending time with family. Max served terms on school boards in Goshen County and in his younger years was an avid member of shooting clubs. He was proud of all of the medals he had won during those times. Max and Iona married June 20, 1951. He is survived by one son, Gary Robinett, of Torrington and 3 daughters, Linda and her husband Ken Keener of Marsland, NE, Susan, and her husband Mike Neilly of Colorado City, CO and Sally, and her husband Joe Cole of Torrington; 9 grandkids and 16 great grandkids. Also, a special ‘son in law’ Doug Herdt. He is preceded in death by his wife Iona, his

parents and an infant brother. Services will be held at 1:00 p.m., Friday, March 12th at Colyer Funeral Home with limited capacity.
