



Micheal "Cuz" Schilreff

November 27, 1951 - August 12, 2014

Micheal A. "Cuz" Schilreff, 62, died Tuesday, Aug. 12, 2014 at the Goshen Care Center and cremation has taken place. Memorial services will be held at 1 p.m. Friday, Aug. 15, at the First Wyoming United Presbyterian Church with Reverend Vicki Kintzel officiating. Mike was born Nov. 27, 1951 in Scottsbluff, the son of George and Leona (Sterkel) Schilreff. He grew up and received his early education in Commerce City, Colo. His family moved to Torrington, Wyo. in 1964 and he graduated from Torrington High School in 1970. He was very mechanically inclined and could fix or work on just about anything that came up. Shortly after graduation he won the state Chrysler/Plymouth Troubleshooting Contest and later participated in the national contest where he placed 12th. After high school Mike started out as a mechanic for the Ford Tractor Dealership in Torrington and then became a contractor working sheetrock all over the state of Wyoming. In 1974 he starting farming the Laramie River Ranch but still did sheetrock contracting in the winter. He married Marcia Knadler on Dec. 6, 1975 in Fort Laramie, Wyo. In 1980 he started contract work for the Sprint telephone company as a service technician and later became a full time technician for Sprint. He retired from there in 2009.

Mike enjoyed golf, fishing, trap shooting, gardening, and yard work. He

especially loved spending time with his grandchildren Tyger, Tayte, Owen, and Afton.

Mike is survived by his wife Marcia of Torrington; son, Ryan Schilreff and daughter, Alicia Marie Rodriguez both of Torrington; brothers, George Schilreff and David Schilreff and sister, Shirley Oliver all of Torrington; half sister, Patty Schilreff of Casper, Wyo.; and four grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; half brothers Donnie and George Schilreff; and his grandparents.
