



## Nancy "Jo" Brooks

grandchildren and great-grandchildren and watching them grow. She was an avid Colorado Sports enthusiast especially for the Avalanche, Rockies and was very happy when the Nuggets won the championship.

After 2020, Jo suffered from sudden illness and her health slowly deteriorated.
