Nathan Homer Blackstone, 94, died Monday, June 18, 2012 at the Chimney Rock Villa in Bayard. On his return from the service he did what he loved, working on ranches as a cowhand in Wyoming and Nebraska. He married Ora Douglas on April 25, 1959. The resided in Alliance where was employed by the City of Alliance. Upon his retirement they moved to Torrington, Wyo. where he resided until his passing. Nathan was one of eight children. He leaves to mourn his passing, his sister Mary Newman of Colorado Springs, Colo.; sister-in-law, Mary Ann Blackstone of Bayard; and many nephews and nieces.
