### NORMAN H. MCCABE

TORRINGTON, Wyoming – Norman H. McCabe, 80, died at home Wednesday, July 27, 2016.

Graveside memorial services will be held at 10 a.m. Monday, August 1, at the Valley View Cemetery with Bill Eaton officiating. Cremation has taken place.

Norman was born November 6, 1935 in Lingle, Wyoming the son of Herbert and May (Moorehouse) McCabe. He attended school in Torrington and graduated from Torrington High School in 1954. After school, Norman served in the US Army from 1958-60. After completing boot camp in Fort Hood, Texas he boarded a train and then a ship bound for Germany. He was in Germany for two years as an Army Tank Mechanic. After receiving an honorary discharge, he returned to Torrington. Norman married Karen Broers on July 8, 1961. He worked at Deluxe Body Shop from 1960-67 and then the Covello Motor Company for 30 years and retired in 1997.

For 25 years Norman would respond helping to save lives and property at fires, motor vehicle accidents and other emergencies. Norman was a member of the Torrington Volunteer Fire Department since 1970. He held various offices in TVFD over the years. His dedication to the department included

serving as Fire Chief for 6 years. Norman was President of the Wyoming State Firearms Association; he was a drill team member for 23 years and he was a State Timer for 10 years. Norman attended 43 consecutive fire conventions. In 2015, Norman was recognized by the Torrington Volunteer Fire Department for 45 years of service. He loved the Fire Department and he enjoyed collecting toy fire trucks and other fire equipment.

Survivors include his wife Karen of Torrington; son Marvin (Jolynn) McCabe of Arizona; son Kevin (Erin) McCabe of Virginia; Granddaughter Mandy of Arizona; Great Grandsons Kaden, General III and Christopher of Arizona; and numerous relatives and friends.

He is preceded in death by his parents; brother Lester; sister Elsie and son Harvey.
