She is survived by her son, Charles and his wife Myrna of Torrington; a daughter-in-law, Dorothy Stuckert of Gering, Nebraska; four grandchildren, Lisa Moore of Longmont, Colorado; Diana Hessler and husband Steve of Gering, Nebraska; Robert Stuckert of Laramie, Wyoming; and Douglas Stuckert and wife Joy of Gering, Nebraska; six great
