She married Henry Schmick on Jan. 15, 1956 in Torrington and they moved to Cheyenne, Wyoming. She again attended UW and received her BA in education. She taught in Sheridan, Wyoming from 1972 until 1995 when she retired. They lived in Sheridan until 2009 when they returned to Cheyenne.

Pamela enjoyed playing Bridge and tennis and camping. She was a member of several Bridge clubs and was a member of Kappa Delta Sorority and UW.

Pamela is survived by her husband Henry of Cheyenne, Wyo.; two sons Douglas H. Schmick and Daniel J. (Jan) Schmick both of Colorado Springs, Colo.; a brother Clifton (Patty) Wood of Torrington, Wyo.; and four grandsons Darell Schmick of Salt Lake City, UT, Jordan (Emily) Schmick of Arvada, Colo, and Hunter and Ryan Schmick both of Colorado Springs. She was preceded in death by her parents; and a sister Eileen.
