He is survived by his daughter, Chelsea of Cheyenne, Wyoming; a sister Sandy Wells of Torrington, Wyoming; a brother Jack Mitchell of Scottsbluff,

Nebraska; his twin brother Mike Mitchell and his wife Vicki of Sidney, Nebraska; sisters-in-law, Georgia Mitchell of Laramie, Wyoming; and Judy Mitchell of Cheyenne, Wyoming; two aunts, Betty Eddleman of Wheatland, Wyoming, and Erma Petty of Gering, Nebraska; as well as numerous cousins, nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers, Larry and Ed; one sister-in-law, Terry Mitchell, and two great nieces.
