For the next 49 wonderful years Patty worked as a teacher’s

assistant in North Carolina, helped her husband start churches in Michigan and Wyoming. Their one only miracle daughter Rebekah, was born August 14, 1984, in Thomasville, North Carolina. The rest of Patty's life was spent involved in her family, her church, and in various business ventures. These include sewing from home, owning the Longhorn Grocery & Café in LaGrange, Wyoming. Patty also served in food service in senior centers in Cheyenne, Torrington, and LaGrange, Wyoming. Patty's hobbies included cooking, baking, reading, crocheting, and drinking Pepsi. She loved being a grandmother and watching her grandchildren grow up as well as spoiling them with unnecessary gifts and stuffed animals on shopping trips. Patty also enjoyed making crocheted gifts and items for friends, family, and her home in her pastime. In her last week, Patty suffered a ruptured brain aneurysm.
