Laramie Community Church, the Ladies VFW Auxiliary #4471, and an honorary member of the Ft. Laramie Historical Association. She was also active in the Senior Friendship Center and served on the Advisory Council and the Goshen County Senior Friendship Board. Patty is survived by her husband Robert of Ft. Laramie, Wyoming; twin sons, Robert Milligan Jr. of Ft. Saint John, BC Canada, and Rudy Milligan of Carlsbad, New Mexico; two daughters, Tamara Gorsuch of Sioux Falls, South
