Rebecca Lynn Haas, 42, died Sunday, April 22, 2012 at Cheyenne Regional Medical Center in Cheyenne, Wyoming. Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Friday, April 27, at the First Baptist Church in Torrington with Pastor Rick McGraw officiating. Burial will follow in the Valley View Cemetery in Torrington.
