REGINA CONNIE FLORES, 79, passed away peacefully on August 15, 2025, at North Colorado Medical Center in Greeley, Colorado. A viewing will be held on Friday, August 22nd from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m. at Colyer Funeral Home. A Rosary service will follow at 7:00 p.m. at St. Rose Catholic Church. A Funeral Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated on Saturday, August 23rd at 11:30 a.m. at St. Rose Catholic Church, with interment to follow at Valley View Cemetery. Regina was born on February 3, 1946, in South Torrington, Wyoming, to George and Frances (Palato) Reyes. She grew up in the Torrington area, attending local schools and graduating from Torrington High School in 1964. She later earned a Secretarial Science degree from Goshen County Community College. Regina dedicated 25 years of service as a teller at Pinnacle Bank in Torrington, where her warm smile and kind heart left a lasting impression on colleagues and customers alike. Even after retiring in 2008, she continued to work part-time until her health no longer allowed her to do so. Family was at the heart of everything Regina did. She cherished time spent with her parents, siblings, children, grandsons, and many nieces and nephews. Known for her generous spirit, she was always ready to help others however she could. Her social nature and love for people made her a familiar and beloved presence in the community. She maintained friendships from her years at the bank and always made a point to stay connected, even as her health declined. A passionate sports fan, Regina proudly supported her Minnesota

Vikings and was a faithful attendee of Torrington High School football and basketball games. Her greatest joy, however, was cheering on her grandsons at their basketball and soccer games, concerts, and high school plays. She also loved reading, watching movies, dancing, shopping, collecting jewelry, and enjoying music of all kinds. Regina was a devout Catholic and a dedicated member of the Guadalupe Society. She actively supported her parish by assisting with bookkeeping and deposits and took pride in her faith and community. She was deeply loved by her family and many friends—and she loved them all in return. Regina is survived by her son Adrian Flores of Torrington; grandsons, Damon, Devin, and Dylan Flores all of Torrington; brothers, George (Ecil) Reyes of Torrington, Louis (Linda) Reyes of Gering, Richard (Becky) Reyes of Torrington and Raymond (Beverly) Reyes of San Antonio, Texas; and sisters Kathy Reyes and Patricia Reyes, both of Torrington. She was preceded in death by her daughter, JoAnna Costello (Flores), and her parents, George and Frances Reyes.
