



## Richard "Dick" Kirchhefer

August 17, 1931 - November 14, 2018

Dick was born August 17, 1931 in Torrington, Wyoming the son of Frederick and Mary (Welch) Kirchhefer. At the age of ten his family moved to a farm southwest of Yoder, Wyoming and he received his education in Yoder graduating from Yoder High School. He attended the University of Wyoming for a short time before returning to the family farm. He married Mary Hunt in Yoder on June 10, 1956. In 1974 they bought a hotel in Guernsey, Wyoming and operated it until 1977. He went to work for the uranium mine in Shirley Basin in 1976 and was there until 1983 when they returned to the farm in Yoder. He farmed his farm and worked for other farmers in the area until he moved to Guernsey to live with his daughter in 2017.

Dick enjoyed leatherwork, reading, playing computer games, hunting and did some rodeo when he was younger. He was a member of the Yoder

Presbyterian Church and the Mountain Empire Dairymen's Association.

Dick is survived by two sons Gary (Shelly) Kirchhefer of Torrington, Wyoming and Fred (Donita) Kirchhefer of Douglas, Wyoming; two daughters Robyn (John) Troutd of Guernsey, Wyoming and Kristie (Rob) Pfaff of Cheyenne, Wyoming; nine grandchildren; seven great grandchildren; and one great-great granddaughter. He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife Mary; one brother; a granddaughter; and a grandson.
