After returning from military service, Richard embarked on a career as a truck driver, a profession he embraced for several years before retiring in 2009. His adventurous spirit did not wane during retirement; he found joy in fishing, spending time with his

family, and indulging in his love for garage sales. Richard was a man of many talents, often described as loving, stubborn, charismatic, and always ready for a new project. On July 16, 1989, Richard married the love of his life, Darlene Dike. Together, they shared a beautiful journey filled with laughter, love, and cherished memories. His family was his pride and joy, and he leaves behind his devoted wife, Darlene; his sister, Sheila Hatch (Steve); and his children: daughter Staci McCarty (Justin), son John Dike (Anne), and son Jeramie Dike.
