He dabbled in real estate for a short time before moving to Torrington in 1988 and started work for the State of Wyoming in the Taxation and Revenue Department. Rich enjoyed working on his 1966 and 1967 Pontiac GTO's, hunting, playing cards, traveling with and just being with his family and friends. He always offered to help when it was needed. Rich is survived by his brother Larry Foltz and his wife Kathy of Torrington, Wyoming; a sister Sharon Adam of Lancaster, California; nephews Charles Adam of Los Angeles, California and Casey Foltz
