The couple lived a short time in Mitchell and then moved to Torrington in September. Dick's hobby was horses. He liked roping and trail riding in the Black Hills and various places. He really enjoyed spending time with his boys and being involved in 4-H (with horses).

He was the Vice President of the Northern Colorado Quarter Horse Association for several years; a member of the National Reining Horse Association; a 4-H leader; and he coached Little League and basketball.

Survivors include his wife Ann Thomas of Torrington; his son Kenneth (Susie) Thomas of Veteran, WY; his son Keith (Stacy) Thomas of Mitchell, NE and his granddaughter Lindsey Thomas of Mitchell.
