Roger LeRoy Sargent, 69, passed away peacefully at home Wednesday, Dec. 7, 2016.

Memorial services will be held 10 a.m. Wednesday, Dec. 14, at the First Wyoming Presbyterian Church, with Pastor Robert Smith officiating. Cremation has already taken place.

Roger was born March 26, 1947 in Redfield, South Dakota the son of Roger Winfield and Edna Verna (Harmening) Sargent. He grew up in Wessington, where he graduated high school in 1965. After graduating, Roger enlisted and served in the United States Navy from 1965-1969, serving two tours in Vietnam, aboard the USS Tioga County.

After his service, Roger worked various jobs before starting his Railroad career with the Chicago North & Western and Union Pacific Railroads in 1970. He began working in the Roundhouse in Huron before becoming a Brakeman and a Conductor. He completed his career in South Morrill Nebraska as a Conductor and Peer Trainer, retiring in 2007 with 37 years of service.

On June 3, 1973 Roger was united in marriage to Karen Lucille Shoemaker and from that union they had four children; daughter Kari and three sons, Jamie, Scott, and Brett. Roger took pride in his family and embraced them

with much love and support. He enjoyed time with his twelve grandchildren, where he was committed to give and love unconditionally, share laughter, engage in conversations, and always desired to put a smile on their face through his fun loving yet silly expressions. Roger also valued and enjoyed the time he spent with his siblings, whether it was fishing trips or family gatherings.
