Ronald Eugene Kautz, age 88, died at Davis Hospice Center in Cheyenne on January 24, 2022. He was born in McGrew, Nebraska to Conrad and Katherine Kautz on June 4, 1933. Ronnie graduated from Lyman High School in 1951, and began farming with his father near Lyman. He married Margaret Lucille Johnson on June 26, 1953. In 1965 he purchased a farm near Huntley, Wyoming, and farmed there until his retirement in 2016.

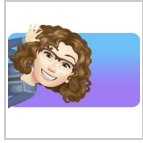
