



## Ronald Schwartzkopf

November 24, 1937 - October 10, 2013

In 1969 Ron moved his family to Ogallala, Nebraska where he helped build and later worked for Union 76. He later divorced and moved to Sterling, Colorado where he met and married Lois Loft. Ron worked for Allen Mitchek for several years and retired there. He and Lois moved to Julesburg, Colorado a few years ago.

Survivors include his wife Lois Schwartzkopf of Julesburg, Colorado; daughter Cindi (Carol) Ward of Chilton, Texas, sons Mike (Debbie) Schwartzkopf of Lubbock, Texas and Larry (Polly) Schwartzkopf of Oshkosh, Nebraska; daughter Tammy (Dave) Relka of Scottsbluff, Nebraska; sister June Herdt of Torrington, Wyoming; twin brother Daniel Schwartzkopf of Ogallala; brother Jack Schwartzkopf of Torrington; eleven grandchildren; eighteen great grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.
