She grew up and received her education in Wheatland and Veteran, Wyoming graduating high school in Wheatland. She married Bernie Huckfeldt on October 26, 1950 and they moved to Torrington, Wyoming and she worked as the bookkeeper for the Huckfeldt Trucking Company. They sold the business to their son in 1986. They moved to Dubois, Wyoming where they owned and operated the Dubois Motel and later the Sawmill Lodge. They then purchased a house on Union Pass where they enjoyed fishing, hunting and snowmobiling. Later they moved back to Dubois and wintered in Bullhead City, Arizona. In 2014 the couple moved into the Goshen Healthcare Community. Bernie died March 13, 2016.

Ruth enjoyed snowmobiling, fishing and their friends in Bullhead City, Arizona.

Ruth is survived by a son Dennis (Cindi) Huckfeldt and a daughter Sandra (Blair Newman) Huckfeldt all of Torrington, Wyoming; and numerous nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband Bernie; and two brothers Arthur Stamm and Byron Stamm. "Bruce" has been resting for three years so she could be with Bernie.
