Shiloh W. Brown, 31, died Jan. 12, 2012 from injuries received at work. Funeral services will be held at 1 p.m. Tuesday, Jan. 17, at the Goshen County Rendevous Center with Pastor Scott Mathis officiating. Burial will take place at the Brown Cemetery near Montpelier, N.D. Memorials may be given to an education fund for his niece Hayden Matzke. The casket will be closed. He grew up and received his early education in Montpelier, N.D. and then at the age of ten his family moved to Lingle, Wyo. During high school he participated in High School Rodeo and competed nationally in team roping and in 1997 he was on the Wrangler All-star Team and ended up thirteenth in the world. He graduated Lingle High School in 1998. Shiloh attended one year at Eastern Wyoming College where he again participated in rodeo. He moved to Sheridan, Wyo. and worked on the Eatons Guest Ranch for seven years. He moved back to Torrington and worked at Smitty's Repair as a welder for four and a half years. In 2009 he started working for Scott Salo and became his right hand man. Shiloh enjoyed golfing and cooking. He loved his dogs and team roping. He was a past member of the USTRC and the ACTRA. Shiloh is survived by his parents Nathan and Karen Brown of Lingle, Wyo.; sister, Wendy Matzke and husband Jace of Wheatland, Wyo.; niece, Hayden Reece Matzke of Wheatland; paternal grandfather, Darrel Brown of Montpelier, N.D.; numerous

aunts, uncles and cousins among them his special aunts, Pam Marsolek and Denise Triepke. Preceding Shiloh in death was his paternal grandmother and maternal grandparents.
