Ted was born September 12, 1907 in Russell, Kansas the son of Henry and Katherine (Eurich) Wagner. He moved with his family to Scottsbluff, Nebraska and then in 1917 the family moved to Cody, Wyoming where he attended school. They stayed there for three years before moving to Powell, Wyoming where they farmed for four years. In 1924 when he was sixteen they moved to Lingle, Wyoming. He moved to Bayard, Nebraska in 1927 where he worked briefly for his uncle and at the sugar factory before moving back to Lingle to work for his brother Henry. Ted married Martha Hergert on November 20, 1932 in Lingle. They farmed in Lingle until 1940 when they moved to Torrington, Wyoming to farm until 1944 when they purchased a farm near Veteran, Wyoming. They retired in 1971 and moved back to Torrington. He entered Goshen Care Center in June of 2000. Ted is survived by two daughters, Ruth Pearson and her husband Lamoine of Loveland, Colorado, and Violet McCain and her husband Roy of Lincoln, Nebraska; one brother Albert Wagner and his wife Barbara of Riverton, Wyoming; two sisters, Alma Schmidt and Edith Nab both of

Saginaw, Michigan; five grandchildren; nine great grandchildren; and one great-great grandchild. He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife; six brothers, Henry, Leo, Paul, Riney, Victor, and Adolph; and one sister Mollie Davis.
