She grew up and received her education in the Lingle, Wyoming area, graduating from high school there in 1928. She worked as a telephone operator in Torrington for three years and then married Wilmer Reid Gamble on February 10, 1932. The couple made their home in Torrington until 1948. They lived in Sheridan, Wyoming, where she worked for J.C. Penney and then moved to Casper, Wyoming where she was employed by Sears. They returned to Torrington in 1955 and she worked at J.C. Penney and later worked as an assessor for the county. Vadah was a member of the First Wyoming United Presbyterian Church where she was active in the Women's Association and participated in Bible Study groups in the community. She liked gardening, and sewing, particularly making clothing for her daughters. Vadah is survived by three daughters, Betty Jean Horton and her husband Jim, Mary Lu Pollat, and Dorothy Harshberger and her husband Chuck all of Torrington,

Wyoming; eleven grandchildren; twenty-five great grandchildren; and eleven great-great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband; two brothers; four sisters; and one great granddaughter.
