He was born William Francis Morgan, the son of Albert and Ruth (Schoolman) Morgan on April 22, 1913 in Good Pasture, Colorado. When Francis was six months old the family left in covered wagons, along with their horses, equipment and household goods, and settled in Yoder country on a homestead near Kessler Gap. Francis bought his own farm when he was eighteen years old in 1931. He used two tractors to move an existing house on another farm. In 1940 he married Leatha Frasier in Gering, Nebraska. Francis along with Al Barkman bought a community hall and started the local Farmer's Union in the 1940's. He ran the Panhandle Coop in Veteran as well as the Phillips Sixty-Six station in Torrington Francis and Rudy Rutar were also key founders of Community Share in the 1990's. He loved farm duties and all the things that farming entailed, along with helping

others when he could.

He is survived by a step-son Harry Grout of Veteran; five granddaughters, Brenda and Dean Wilson of Veteran, Leatha and Patrick Reichert of Huntley, WY., Loretta and David Robinson of Virginia, Leatha and Peggy Grout, both of Germany; two grandsons, Eddie and Ron Grout, both of Virginia; twelve great-grandchildren and one great-great grandchild Addison, along with numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, wife, four brothers, one sister, and one son Floyd.
