



Wayne Ervin Hahn

June 10, 1929 - October 29, 2015

TORRINGTON, WY WAYNE ERVIN HAHN, 86, passed away peacefully at Torrington Community Hospital on Wednesday, October 29, 2015 after a courageous battle with cancer. Mary, his wife of 60 years, was by his side, along with many family members. Memorial services will be held at the United Methodist Church in Torrington at 1:30 pm on Tuesday, November 3rd with Reverend Matt Gordon and Reverend Brian Kroeger co-officiating. Wayne was born June 10, 1929 the son of Reuben and Ruby (Benshoof) Hahn on their ranch east of Jay Em, WY. He started school at a one room schoolhouse, moved into Prairie Center through the 10th grade, then transferred to Torrington High School where he graduated in 1948. He studied at Eastern Wyoming College prior to joining the Army National Guard in 1949. Eventually he was drafted into active duty and served with the 10th Mountain Division and the 7th Infantry Division during the Korean War from March 1952 – May 1953. Upon his return he wed Mary Hughes on February 27, 1955. The two began their family and farm/ranch business four miles north of Torrington. Wayne's love of family and ranching was the driving force behind his lifelong

success. He was always quick with a smile and personified the statement “he never met a stranger”. His even temper, quick wit and friendly demeanor led him into many community service roles. These included, President of Arnold Drain, a member of the Goshen County Fair Board, two terms as Goshen County Commissioner, and numerous other youth volunteer positions. Wayne was also a 62 year member of American Legion Post #1. A big part of Wayne and Mary’s life was the United Methodist Church and Gleaner’s Union.
