He attended God's Bible School and College in Cincinnati, Ohio where he graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Theology in 1960. He married Gertrude Miktuk in Ashville, New York on June 13, 1959. Bill started Pastoring in East Liverpool, Ohio with the Allegheny Wesleyan Methodist Church. He Pastored in other places including Punxutawney, Pennsylvania, North Springfield, Pennsylvania, Mentole, Pennsylvania, LaGrange, Wyoming, Franklin, Pennsylvania, and Alberton, Montana. He retired in 2005 and was engaged in farming with his son in

Wheatland, Wyoming while also Pastoring in Chugwater at he Pioneer Pilgrim Chapel.

Bill loved to hunt with his family, woodworking and farming. He served with the Allegheny Wesleyan Methodist Youth Committee thirteen years as treasurer. He worked with Allegheny Youth and Missions and served five years at the Northwest Indian Bible School.

Bill is survived by his wife Gertrude of Wheatland, Wyoming; a son Sam Rosengreen and his wife Mary of Cheyenne, Wyoming; a sister Nancy Dunlap and her husband Ed of Franklin, Pennsylvania; two grandsons, Wesley Rosengreen and his wife Andrea of Cheyenne, and Shirl Rosengreen of Hawaii; and a granddaughter Melissa Rosengreen of Cheyenne. He was preceded in death by his parents.
